# IDIOMS

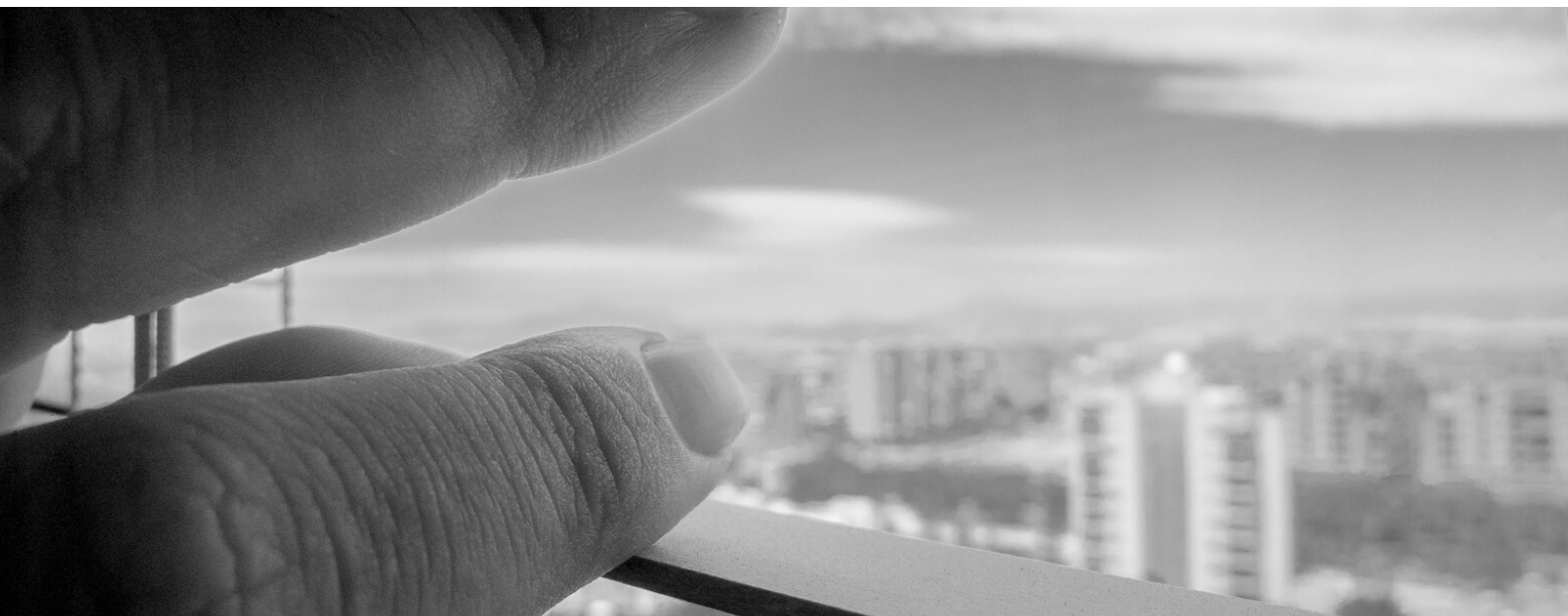


feel at ease: to feel comfortable and relaxed
