meticulous: showing great attention to detail; very precise

tedious: too long, slow, or dull; tiresome

At my job, I bake 1,000 loaves of bread a day. It's such a tedious thing to do.

impetuous: done quickly without any care or attention to detail

My husband wasn't very thorough when he bought our house. He saw an advertisement, called up, and impetuously paid.
