CHARACTER

Read up on this TV show character. It's important info for understanding this topic!

Walter White is the main character of the Breaking Bad TV show. A graduate of the California Institute of Technology, Walt was once a promising chemist who helped start the company Gray Matter Technologies with his close friend. He left Gray Matter suddenly, selling his shares for \$5,000; soon afterward, the company made a fortune, much of it from his research. Walt then moved to Albuquerque, New Mexico, where he became a high school chemistry teacher. The TV series Breaking Bad begins on Walter's fiftieth birthday when he is diagnosed with Stage III lung cancer. After this discovery, he resorts to manufacturing **meth** and **drug dealing** to make sure his family can survive financially after his death. He is pulled deeper into the illegal drug trade, becoming more and more ruthless as the series progresses, and later adopts the name "Heisenberg", which becomes recognizable as the kingpin figure in the local drug trade. Walt's change from mild-mannered school teacher and family man to ruthless criminal master and murderer is the show's central focus.

USEFUL WORDS

Read and practice the vocabulary below.

meth - nickname for methamphetamine, an illegal drug that is created through the mixing of different chemicals. It is believed to be extremely dangerous and addictive and is one of the most problematic drugs in the United States today

During World War II, **methamphetamine** was sold in tablet form under the brand name Pervitin produced by a pharmaceutical company. It was used extensively by all branches of the combined Wehrmacht armed German forces (Nazis).

drug dealing - the selling of illegal drugs

Walter white decided to begin **drug dealing** after he was diagnosed with cancer.

ruthless - having or showing no pity or compassion for others

That kid is **ruthless**, he took all the other kids candy for himself and slowly ate it in front of them!

kingpin - a person or thing that is essential to the success of an organization or operation; the leader of a crime organization

Have you ever seen the movie 'The Godfather'? Marlon Brando played a big kingpin.

mild-mannered - (of a person) gentle and not given to extremes of emotion

Steve became much more mild-mannered after he got married.
